

Declaration of no obligation to submit 2023-24 annual return - Independent candidate, independent elected member or independent group

Section 217M of the *Electoral Act 2002* requires independent candidates, independent elected members and independent groups to submit an annual return for the 2023-24 financial year if:

- they received political donations from any single donor during the financial year, and
- any of those donations which (in aggregation) met (or exceeded) the disclosure threshold.

Political donations include self-contributions from a candidate, member or group to their own election campaign.

The disclosure threshold for the 2023-24 financial year is \$1,170.

If you **do not** need to submit a 2023-24 financial year annual return, complete the following declaration to notify the Victorian Electoral Commission (VEC).
